What a faith goal is not:

- It is not a vow, it is a goal you are believing for by faith.
- It is not a bondage. It is a faith projection to a specific target. No one will come to collect it.
- It is not a transfer of the tithe. That belongs in the local church and helps meet operational needs.
- It is not dependant on your ability to pay. It is not made on the basis of what is possible for you to do from your present income. It is a faith goal and faith is dependant on God.
- Faith giving is money God gives through you, which he would not give to you if He
 did not trust you to pass it on.

What a faith goal is:

- It is an agreement between you and God. Your name WILL NOT BE RECORDED. Individual faith goal are totalled and this figure will be a guide for the church leadership as they believe and pray with you towards the faith goal for the church.
- It is becoming specific in faith. This is a key to receiving answers from God. Know exactly what you are believing for.
- It is a step of response to hearing from heaven.
- It is a step of personal growth. This does not leave goal setting to church leaders. It involves us all.
- It is a lifting of vision and faith. Instead of limiting our giving to the level of our resources, we lift our vision and faith to the abundance of His resources.
- It is a divine grace, a supernatural enabling.
- It is a deepening spiritual experience, for we are giving of ourselves as we give of our substance. Faith stretches us past former boundaries into new areas in God
